Worming

An all-year-round worming programme is essential for every horse or pony whatever their age. Regular worming at the correct time interval with the most appropriate type of wormer helps to prevent ill thrift, colic, respiratory disease, diarrhoea and even death.

Additional measures of worm control, especially in heavily grazed situations, include picking up droppings from the paddocks, chain harrowing, shared grazing with sheep or cattle, and paddock rotation if at all possible.

The effectiveness of a worm control programme can be monitored by regularly submitting dropping samples from individual horses to us for worm egg counts. The level of tapeworm infestation can be monitored by the use of a blood test.
